About the New Kodak ASN Number

Kodak requires a unique ASN (Advanced Ship Notice) number for United's Wrap N Label. The ASN is a fourteen digit character code that is comprised of the four character vendor ID and the ten digit purchase order number. The ASN number is barcoded for scanning purposes. Each order must have a unique ASN number therefore, each order must be on its own purchase order.

Setting Up The New Feature

You must set up the following to use this new feature:

- Set up the (L6F) United Communications Screen.
 - This screen must be set up specifically for this feature. To do this, specify an unused location in the United Parameters field.
 - You must have ADOT turned off.
 - You must be set up for Wrap N Label.
 - You must have barcodes set up.
- Modify the ASB parameters. (For more information on ASB parameters, see your online help.)
 - You will need to set up a separate vendor call number and add this call number to the launcher.
 - Each order must have a separate purchase order.
 - Also, you may need to set up customers with separate routes to be used in ASB.
 - You must specify the unique location that you set up in the (L6F) screen in the third subscreen.

Setting Up the (L6F) Screen

- 1 Go to the text-based (L6F) screen.
- 2 This screen must be set up specifically for this feature. To do this, specify an unused location in the United Parameters field.
- 3 Press Tab to move to the ADOT field. Type N.
- 4 In the W-N-L field, type Y.
- 5 Press Tab to move to the Barcode field. Type A.
- 6 Press Enter to save your changes.
