

What's New in Dealer Station DDMS Edition 2.8

- **Creating Multiple Default User Settings**

You can create multiple default user settings. You can customize these settings for any type of customer, for example by region or pricing contract. You can also customize by user level. - **Mass Emailing Customers**

You can create and send mass emails directly from Dealer Station. This feature makes it easy to send marketing messages and other announcements to all or selected customers. For more information, see **Setting Up Dealer Station DDMS Edition Admin Pages, Chapter 7, User Accounts on page 50.**

- **Setting Up a Privacy Policy**

The Site Text section allows you to add or modify a privacy policy in HTML. You can add a privacy policy link to your end-users home page for them to view. - **Turning Off Quick Search**

A new box in Default User Settings and User Accounts allows you to turn off the Quick Search feature from all your site's users or for specific users. - **Creating a Maintenance Message**

- **Ignoring Substitutions/Alternates**

In Default User Settings, the Ignore option has been added to substitution and alternate items.
