- **Creating Parameters for Checking Out**

You can set preferences, or parameters for your end-user when they have completed an order and want to checkout. The parameters set here showup on the Checking Out page. You can customize the text on this page, select credit card payment options and determine the information available for view. - **New Customizing Text Options**

- **Adding Comments to Favorites Items**

- **Continue Shopping Link**

You can now set a link on the end user's checkout page that will return them to the catalog. You can determine whether your customers will have this optional link and you customize the text. - **Override Home Page Link**
